

**Masks**: We are delighted that our students are wearing masks properly during the school day overall. . Here are a few reminders of how you can help support us in this important safety measure:

HOwever, We also have a great responsibility to follow the established safety protocols and ensure that all visitors follow this practice of entry only through the front doors.

# ASSESSMENT DAYS AUGUST 30th and SEPTEMBER 3rd

As a result of the Colorado Basic Literacy Act and the need to assess each student's reading abilities with individualized assessments, it is necessary that we schedule our students for individual assessment times on Monday, August 30th and Friday, September 3rd.

Students in grades K-2 come on either Monday, August 30th or Friday, September 3rd for only their scheduled assessment time. These students should arrive at the front entrance of the school and walk to their inside classroom door.

Students in grades 3, 4, & 5 come for a full school day (8:30am - 3:00pm) on Monday, August 30th for MAP testing. These students will arrive at their outside classroom door as they do on a normal school day.



We thank you for your cooperation in regard to these assessment days.


