Greetings Families!

We are closing out the 2021 half of the year and seeing many reasons to feel good about our progress. While we are still facing challenges due to the Pandemic, we strive to create a safe, caring, and welcoming environment at Westridge each and every day. Here are a few tips to support a strong finish to this segment of the school year:

- 1. Share a positive moment with your child before the school day.
- 2. Arrive at School on time for a healthy start to the school day.
- 3. Make sure that your child comes to school with a fully charged device.
- 4. Ask your student what makes them smile about school.
- 5. Share reading time as a family to demonstrate a home to school connection and value for our learning goals.

Student Covid-19 Vaccine Status Update: Please send us a copy of your child's Covid-19 vaccination status once they are fully vaccinated. The definition of being fully vaccinated for kids is a two shot protocol. Immunity is valid once a student is two weeks post their second dose. Based on when the vaccine was approved for children, we are approaching the time when kids will be considered fully vaccinated including the two week immunity period. From here on out, before we identify close contacts who could potentially need to quarantine, we will need to check vaccination status. At Westridge we have been fortunate to not need to quarantine a classroom this current school year.






