



#### **Greetings Westridge Community,**

**Kiss and Go Lane**: Here are a few tips and expectations to help all of us maintain a safe and positive school culture:

- The Kiss and Go Lane is designed to be a place where drivers pull forward, stop, and allow students to exit the car quickly and walk independently to their classroom door.
- Drivers are expected to be respectful when asked by staff members to pull forward.
- Drivers must stay in the car and exit the lane once students exit the vehicle.

**School Parking Lot:** If your family needs more time to get to the classroom doors, you may park your car in the parking lot. This allows students and families extra time to gather belongings and exit the car at a slower pace.

**DRIVE is ALIVE!** Westridge is a PBIS School, meaning we use a framework called PBIS, or Positive Behavioral Intervention Support, as a schoolwide framework to support all students being positive and kind in our school setting. **COVID SAFETY:** If you or your child is symptomatic we ask that you stay home, test, and return to school only when you/they are no longer symptomatic. As you may have read in the district's Community Update, due to the delays caused by security concerns, **EnrollJeffco Round 1 enrollment will open January 10 and run through January 28, 2022**. All applications received before the close of Round 1 (January 28) will be included in the lottery process for the 2022-2023 school year. Please Note: The time at which a Round 1 EnrollJeffco application is submitted does not increase the priority for enrollment.

- Keep important parts of your design away from the edges of the paper so they don't get cut off if published
- Write your first and last name, grade, and teacher's name in
   Pencil on the BACK of your cover design
- Be creative and HAVE FUN!


**REMEMBER**, purchases will not count for your organization until after your participants register their *loyalty* card.
