How will it be repaired (solution)?

We use these questions with our students to provide a structured conversation leading to a positive outcome where everyone feels heard and valued.

#### JEFFCO SUMMER OF EARLY LEARNING JSEL

Jeffco Summer of early Learning (JSEL) is a free, 6-week, intensive summer school program that focuses on increasing students' literacy skills. The 2022 program will offer both in person and remote options.

Students entering kindergarten - 5th grade for the 2022-23 school year and who are on a READ plan or at risk of needing a READ plan (based on the most current data available) can enroll in JSEL.


#### **Book Fair**
