Restorative Practices: I believe that we can all come together to do great things for each other and our students. When we engage in conversations to resolve a conflict or a disagreement, we use questions like:

What happened?
What are the effects?
Who is responsible for what?
How will it be repaired (solution)?

We use these questions with our students to provide a structured conversation which leads to a positive outcome in which everyone feels heard and valued.

#### **CLASSROOM PLACEMENT FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIFIC NEEDS:**

We are often asked about Westridge's policy on parents' input into selection of a classroom teacher for the following year. These decisions are made very carefully by considering the best learning situation for all of our children. All of our teachers are caring, skilled professionals and are excited & highly qualified to teach at all grade levels; therefore, we discourage parent selection of teachers. When requests come to the office, parents often ask for a teacher who is structured, warm, flexible, and challenges kids. We believe all our teachers fit this description.

However, if you choose to fill out a Classroom Placement Form for Students with Specific Needs for the 2022-2023 school year, please note the following:

- Forms are available in the school office
- Forms are due to Dawn in the school office by Thursday, April 21, 2022
- Any form requesting a specific teacher by name will be returned to you
- No late forms will be accepted
- The final decision of classroom placement will be made by the Principal.

We appreciate your thoughtful consideration of this process.

<u>Jeffco Summer of Early Learning (JSEL)</u> is a free, 6-week, intensive summer school program that focuses on increasing K-5 students' literacy skills. The 2022 program will offer in-person and remote options. Students will work with licensed teachers in small group settings (no more than 15 students in each class) and participate in both independent and guided reading activities.



#### Westridge Elementary PTA Jog-a-Thon Information Thursday, April 21, 2022

#### What is the Jog-a-Thon?

The Jog-a-Thon is an annual PTA fundraiser where students run, walk, or jog for 20-30 minutes. Students are encouraged to collect pledges and the funds raised will support our school's literacy programs. It is a day to celebrate healthy, active lifestyles and come together as a community in support of our school. With the funds raised from past Jog-a-Thons, the PTA has purchased almost 300 Chromebooks and several Mimio boards for Westridge Elementary.

#### How can I help my child(ren) prepare for the Jog-a-Thon?

A Jog-a-Thon and Earth Day bingo card are included in this packet. We encourage you and your child(ren) to select a few activities to complete before the Jog-a-Thon. Students who return a completed Bingo card (5 in a row) by Wednesday, April 20, 2022, will be entered to win a \$10 Nella's gift card.

#### I see there are destination goals. What's this about?

This year's Jog-a-Thon theme is "Wildcats Run the World." Leading up to the Jog-a-Thon, and in celebration of Earth Day, students will be learning about the seven natural wonders of the world. By selecting a natural wonder and setting a goal destination (and the associated number of laps to "reach" the destination), we hope students will get excited about setting and achieving a goal. All students who run at least the number of laps required to "reach" their natural wonder will be entered to win a catered Noodles & Company lunch with Mr. Stein (one student will be selected per natural wonder).

#### Since all students are participating, will they be required to collect pledges?

No. Although we will be encouraging students to collect pledges, we do understand this may not be feasible for all students. All students will receive a Westridge water bottle on prize day and additional prize levels begin at \$50. To achieve our school goal of \$25,000, we are encouraging all students to fundraise at least \$50.

#### How do we support the Jog-a-Thon?

There are several ways you can support the Jog-a-Thon.

- Volunteer We will need several volunteers throughout the day of the event. Volunteers are needed for each
  classroom during their running time slot. Volunteers are also needed to help in various other locations

- Donations We are still accepting donations from companies to provide prizes, monetary donations, or goods
  that we can pass on to our students.

#### How will families be asked to raise money for the Jog-a-Thon?

Your student's pledge sheet is included in this packet. Students will use their pledge sheet to ask friends and family for sponsorship. Online donations are encouraged this year and can be made online at

http://app.memberhub.gives/westridgejat. Pledges can be made on a per lap basis or as a flat donation amount. After the student has completed the Jog-a-Thon, they will receive their lap card detailing the number of laps completed.

\*\*Please note: if a sponsor pledges per lap online, their credit card will be billed automatically once we enter the number of laps completed.\*\*

#### When will we receive pledge sheets?

Your student's pledge sheet is included in this packet. Students are also set up on our online donation site so that friends and family can sponsor them online: http://app.memberhub.gives/westridgejat.

#### How will the PTA use the funds raised?

Funds raised will be used to support Westridge Elementary's literacy program.

#### What can we expect on the day of the Jog-a-Thon?

All students will participate in the Jog-a-Thon. Students in kindergarten through 3rd grade will walk, jog, or run for 20 minutes around a 1/8-mile track. Students in 4th and 5th grade will walk, jog, or run for 30 minutes around a 1/8-mile track. Volunteers will record the number of laps each student completes. At the end of the day, students will receive a card with the number of laps completed.

#### When does the money need to be turned in?

To be eligible for prizes, all money needs to be returned or paid online by April 28, 2022.

#### Is there a school fundraising goal?

Our school fundraising goal is \$25,000. If we achieve our school goal, students will enjoy an in-school movie event! We are encouraging all students to fundraise at least \$50 to help us achieve this goal.

#### Are there prizes?

Yes! Prizes will be awarded at the \$50, \$100, \$150, and \$200 levels. The top three student fundraisers will also receive a prize.

- \$50 fundraised: Westridge Jog-a-Thon t-shirt
- . \$100 fundraised: Westridge JUMBO beach ball
- \$150 fundraised: Personalized color changing cup
- \$200 fundraised: Students will have the opportunity to win a variety of prizes including Denver Zoo tickets, restaurant gift cards, Wings Over the Rockies tickets, Meow Wolf tickets, a Tattered Cover gift certificate, a Red Hen Createry basket, miniature golf vouchers, and more.

#### Are there classroom prizes?

Yes! Classroom popsicle parties will be awarded to the classrooms with the highest percentage of laps completed (K-2 and 3-5) and the highest percentage of funds raised per student (this teacher will also receive \$100 to spend on classroom supplies).
