Q. How do I have a negative balance when meals have been free for two years?
 A. Negative balances continue to grow and follow a student during their time in Jeffco. The negative balance likely preceded the pandemic.

Q. I cannot pay this debt right now. Do you offer a payment plan? A. If you require a payment plan, we can accept payments of any size until your balance is paid off. Interest will not accrue.

Q. What if my student has a negative balance and is graduating this year?
A. Please have your senior check their account balance in the cafeteria before graduation.
If they have money in their account, they can spend it, request a refund, or make a donation.
