

Teaching Your Student Empathy and Kindness

GENERAL INFO:

<u>Empathy</u> - the ability to share and understand the feelings of another

<u>Compassion</u> - empathy in action (doing something to help someone else)

<u>Kid Definition</u>: feeling someone else's feelings in your own heart

STRATEGIES:

1) Have conversations about seeing kindness and being kind. Ask your student, "Did you notice anyone being nice to someone else today?" followed by, "How were you nice to someone today?".

2) Kickstart a family kindness campaign. Do one kind thing for someone each day--this can be inside the home, for a neighbor, or for the community.

3) Check out the <u>Random Acts of Kindness</u> website to find other ways to inspire & practice kindness.

In 2015, there were more than 2,400 students in Jeffco Schools who didn't have a permanent home or a hot meal to go home to at night. As educators we know this affects their ability to perform in the classroom, and as human beings we know what this can do to a student's spirit. Every spring, educators in Jeffco lead Grub Club in order to ensure all students experiencing homelessness in Jeffco can have food throughout the school year.

Jeffco Schools is partnering up again with the Jeffco Action Center **now through March 17**, **2023** to help ensure these students have food. In order to support students, Westridge will be collecting **snack-size trail mix, snack-size chips/pretzels, granola bars, fruit snacks, fruit cups,** and monetary donations (see flyer for QR code). A collection box will be located inside the front doors so staff, students, and parents can drop off donations.


