- Moving OR changing schools over the summer?

Families moving outside of Jeffco or to a charter school need to return their devices to their school; if their school is no longer open the device should be returned to 809 Quail (see map). Families moving within Jeffco can take their device with them to their new school. **5th grade students will take their device to middle school with them for use through 8th grade.** 8th grade students will take their device to high school with them, where they will trade it in for a new device to be used throughout high school.
