

Westridge Elementary is recycling the Unrecyclable with TerraCycle!



Help us go **GREEN** and earn **GREEN** by recycling your hard-to-recycle trash! Westridge is proud to share that we have a TerraCycle recycling hub for common things we toss in the trash that can't be recycled locally. The blue recycling bin with the TerraCycle logo is located across the hall from the main office. Students, parents, staff and faculty are invited to use it. The best part? Just by dropping off trash, you help us raise funds for our school! **We'll use our earnings to fund new outdoor recess equipment and classroom supplies!**

-To date, Westridge has recycled over 845 pounds of trash!

In the 2022/2023 school year we recycled 26 lbs of juice pouches and 53 lbs of squeeze pouches, and that is just from collecting in the cafeteria at lunchtime!


